Deadline to enter: Entries must be **received** by October 1, 2008.

Entry fees:

SOLO SPACE: \$25.00 for a 8'x8' space, plus a 15% commission on sales. **MAG will process sales.** You must provide your own supplies and display equipment, and staff your display.

Individual artists who want to avoid the 15% commission may apply for a group space (see next paragraph). However, group spaces are limited, and preference will be given to group exhibits.

GROUP SPACE: \$100 for a 12'x12' space, or \$200 for a 12'x24' space. Groups must provide their own supplies and display equipment, and staff their displays. Groups may process their own sales.

MAG MEMBERS ONLY: \$25.00 for a solo space (see first paragraph) **OR** display in MAG's space for \$15.00. If you choose the second option, you may bring 6 framed and/or 3D pieces, 10 shrinkwrapped pieces, and 10 notecards. Maximum dimension 30". MAG members pay a 15% commission on sales.

What you may exhibit:

- 2D and 3D original fine art, and reproductions from your originals.
- This event will be held in a public facility; please use judgement in selecting works for exhibit. **The show organizers reserve the right to reject any work which does not meet community standards for content.** (I.e., no nudes, no graphic violence, etc.)

Location of exhibit: Harris Pavilion, 9116 Center Street, Manassas. This is a covered facility; however, it can get windy, so secure your displays.

Receiving: Saturday, October 11, 8.00 a.m.

Parking: The Pavilion has a small lot (enter from Center Street), and there are more spaces on

West Street. However, due to the Farmer's Market, in the morning you cannot enter West Street from Prince William Street. Use the Center Street entrance instead.

Please do not drive into the Pavilion itself.

Show time: Saturday, Oct. 11, 10:00 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Pick up: 4 p.m.
