FEES & COMMISSION

MAG members, \$20. Non-members, \$30. Each artist may enter up to 5 works. The Hylton Center receives 30% of the sales price.

AWARDS

1st: \$250. 2nd: \$125. 3rd: \$75.

WHAT YOU MAY ENTER

This exhibit will be juried. We are looking for high quality, original fine art that reflects the theme of "Virginia's Historic Places". Although Civil War places are encouraged, artists are not limited to these sites.

We will consider paintings, drawings, mixed media, collage, photography, digital art and sculpture, completed within the past 2 years. Works may not exceed 60" in any direction, nor weigh more than 40 pounds. Subject matter such as erotica and violence, and works which are simply copies of historic photos, will not be accepted.

MAG may refuse to exhibit works which are not properly presented. Our presentation standards are enclosed.

June 19-22: Notification of acceptance.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

This exhibit will be juried by CD, photographs or high quality laser printed sheets.

Send entry to: Remains, c/o Manassas Art Guild, P.O. Box 3565, Manassas, VA 20108.

Include the following with your submission:

1. A list of the artwork you are submitting, in the following format:
 - Title of work
 - Medium
 - Dimensions
 - Date Completed
 - Sale Price (mark NFS if not for sale.)
 - A 2-3 line description of each work. This can describe your artistic methods, your thoughts about the work, or any other information you think will increase enjoyment or insight into your work. This statement will not be part of the jury process but will be displayed with your art.
2. Your name and complete address, an email address, and phone number.
3. A check for the proper amount, made out to MAG (Manassas Art Guild, Inc.)
4. One image for each work you are entering. (For 3D work, you may include more than one.)
If you are submitting photos or laser copies, attach your name and the title to the back of each image. If you are submitting a CD (RECOMMENDED), see our guidelines at right.

Incomplete entries will be returned.

In addition, the Hylton Center will require each artist to fill out a "Loan Agreement," which you will receive when you drop off your work.

Submission materials will not be returned. MAG reserves the right to use your photos solely for publicity.

SUBMITTING A CD

Submit all images on a single CD.

Image **resolution** should be at least 300 pixels per inch (ppi).

The image **size** should be 4x6" or nearest equivalent.

Save your images with file names in the following format:

yourlastname_titleofwork.jpg

Make sure the titles in your filename and the titles on your submission sheet match.

Write your full name on the CD itself.

Your name, address etc. and your submission list, should be submitted as hard copy. You may also include a text or pdf version on the CD if you wish.

We encourage you to test your disc prior to submission.

Entries which are incomplete or formatted incorrectly will be returned. If you are not sure how to proceed, please contact MAG for assistance.
